Response from the Mayor

Dear Mr Walton

Thank you for your question, in response

In line with national guidance our constitution is quite explicit in what it regards as unacceptable attendance, and that is 6 months non-attendance; anything short of that can only be handled by discussion, local election at the end of the 4 year term, or by a councillor resigning of their own free will."

As much as I don't condone meeting absence, it has been pointed out to me that many councillors do more than just attend the meetings, and all members of the council are available to members of the public who wish to raise concerns, a lot of councillors do contribute their time to other activities in Congleton, therefore I cannot accuse anyone of wrongdoing by not attending,

Following election there could be circumstances that may impact upon a councillor's ability to contribute towards the council as they themselves initially hoped but I would rather continue to discuss this issue with the councillors directly to support them in upholding the commitments they made until their term is complete.

If anyone politely asked me why I wasn't attending, or even challenged my contribution to the council in general, I would be forthcoming; I expect that others would be too.




